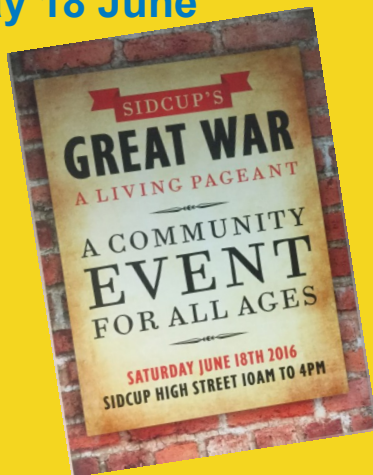

Sidcup Speakability Group had a trip out to the Brands Hatch race circuit on Thursday 12 May and what a great day they had. Thanks to Paul Meaton who arranged the event for the group. Paul and Sue Almond together run this self-help support group for adults suffering speech/communication problems following a stroke or other neurological condition.

Paul said: "We managed to negotiate a special deal with the race circuit that gave us exclusive use of the track and four sports cars each with a professional driver to take all those that wanted to around the track. And most did including those in wheelchairs who could be transferred to sit in one of the cars! Each person was then treated to 2 laps around the track at either a 'slow' speed of up to 70mph or, for those brave enough to take the challenge and don a crash helmet, up to 110mph. Again, most did! It was wonderful to see members

enjoying the experience and doing something they wouldn't now normally be able to do. And prove to themselves that life is for living!

It was a great day out for everyone and the icing on the cake was the weather. After a few days of heavy rain the sun came out so that everyone could spend time watching the cars race around the track and enjoy a picnic lunch arranged through the catering staff at the track."

The QMH old plastic style Staff Car Park Permit will no longer be valid as from Friday 17 June 2016. After this date, warning notices will be issued for one week.

News in Brief

B Block redevelopments are on track. More details will be provided in next month's edition regarding our ALD (Adult Learning Difficulty) service which is scheduled for completion in September 2016.
