

From 16 September 2016 the existing B Block entrance will close, (there is an temporary entrance via C Block), the main entrance and reception remains via A Block.

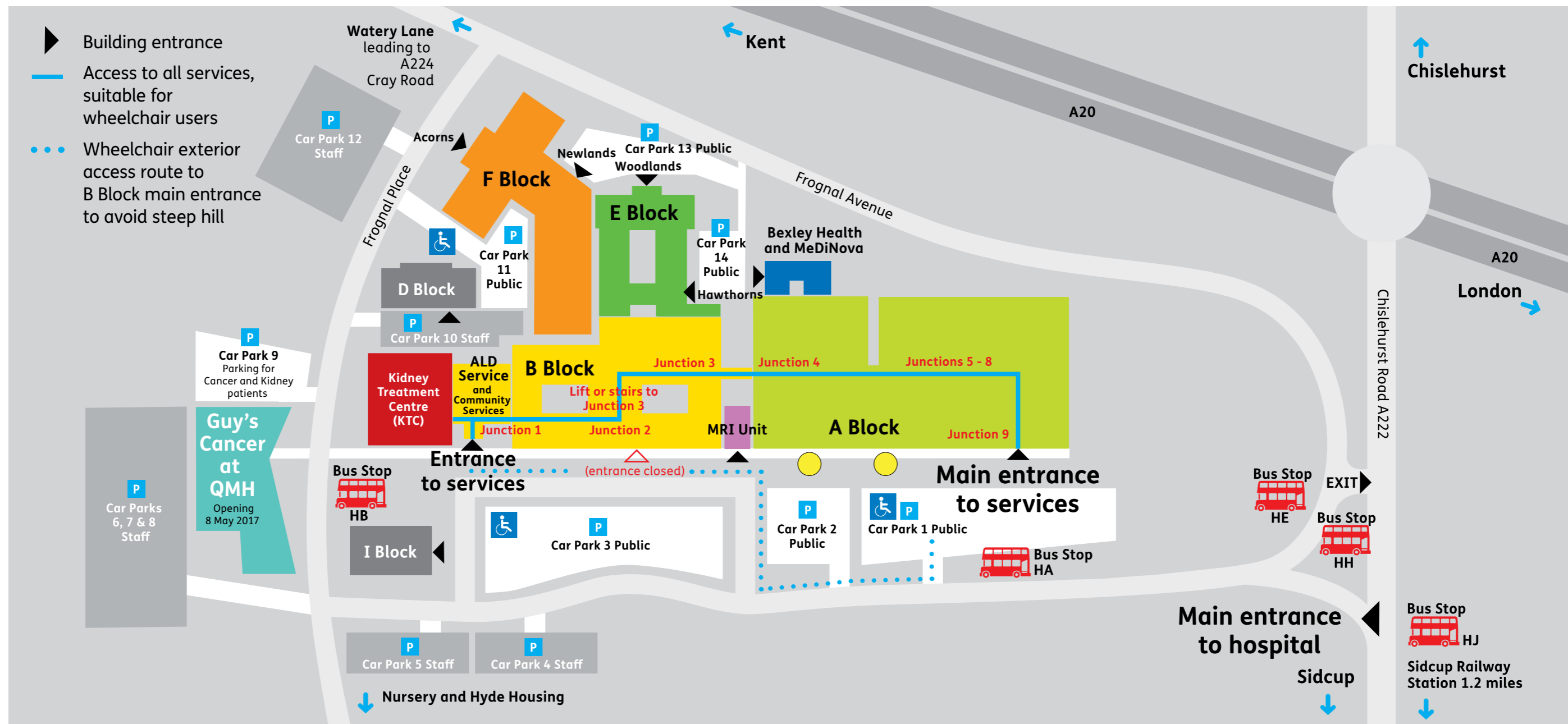
